Through this new regulation, which has its roots from the Energy Ministry Regulation No. 8/2017 on gross splits, oil sharing between the state and contractors is at 57 percent and 43 percent, while in terms of gas sharing portions, the state gets 52 percent while contractors get 48 percent.

This new government breakthrough has been well-received by the Oil and Gas Supporting Industry (INPEMIGAS) association. "As an association that focuses on the supporting sector for the downstream oil and gas industry, we are always monitoring and observing the situation when it comes to gross-split policies for the oil and gas industries, and we always keep in mind the pros and cons of these aforementioned policies," said Bambang Purwohadi, Chairman of INPEMIGAS.

"To be honest, we are currently in a wait-and-see state of mind. Investment in oil and gas is a long-term type of investment. Due to time-consuming factors such as exploration, production and processing, investors can only really enjoy new revenue 15 years after making their investment," Bambang added.
